

## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. What do I gain for immediate recognition when I pass the exam?

- You will be awarded a Certificate stating your accomplishment (available from 10 December 2007 at IFPHK office).
- You will be invited to apply for membership of both CII and IFPHK at the same time.
- Once you become a CII member and IFPHK Associate Member, you will be eligible to indicate the designation **FAIQ (CII)** and **IFPHK Associate Member** on your professional identifications, including name card.

### 2. Can I appeal on my exam result?

No appeal of the exam result will be considered. No appeal system is applied in this qualification exam.

### 3. Am I eligible to sit for the coming exam in April 2008 if I fail this exam? If so, how much does it cost?

Yes, you are eligible to apply for the upcoming exam which will be held on 16 April 2008. The application deadline will be on 5 March 2008. Please submit a completed application to us before the deadline. For application details, please refer to IFPHK website: [www.ifphk.org](http://www.ifphk.org).

The exam fee is HK\$750 for candidates who retake the exam in the same language. No study manual will be given for these candidates. For those who wish to switch/ sit for exam in the other language, they have to settle an exam fee of HK\$1,500 and a study manual of that language will be provided.

### 4. What is the passing score for this exam and how was it determined?

IFPHK does not issue the actual pass mark for any particular sitting. The nominal pass mark for the exam is 70. The pass mark may vary

slightly from exam to exam depending on the level of difficulty of each exam question paper, to ensure that a consistent standard is applied. A pre-defined quota of passes to be awarded does not exist. If all candidates achieve a score of at least the pass mark, then all candidates will be awarded a pass grade.
